

Ratings

Ratings from the July 2011 FIDE list will be used for the Senior Championship. The May 2011 ICU list will be used for all other events, and unrated players in the Senior Championship

Unrated Players

Players without a rating in the May 2011 ICU list must give details of estimated playing strength, including any previously held rating, or current rating from another body.

Notices

The controller reserves the right to transfer players between tournaments at any time. Prizes are indicative and may be amended subject to numbers of entries. Irish players must be members of the ICU. The submission of an entry form and payment of the entry fee is acceptance that the controller's decision is final in all matters. Full terms and conditions can be found at www.e2e4.org.uk. The title of Irish Senior Champion, Intermediate Champion and Junior Champion will be awarded to the highest placed Irish player in each section. All games will be played using digital clocks which will be supplied by e2e4 Chess, together with all sets and boards too!

Early Entry and Discounts

Players may elect to take all of the discounts they are eligible for. Entries received before 31st May 2011 may also take the early entry discount as shown.

Entries will be treated as made on the day that payment is received. Entries or payments on the day will be accepted subject to a €10 additional fee.

Venue

The Green Isle Hotel is located close to Newlands Cross, overlooking the main Dublin to Cork/Limerick N7 dual-carriageway.

How to get there



By Car: From Dublin, follow signs for the N7/Cork/Limerick/Naas Road southbound. You will pass the Red Cow complex on your left. Continue straight ahead. Go straight through the traffic lights at Newlands Cross and take the next exit left marked Kingswood. At the top of the slip road, take the 3rd exit off the roundabout. At the next roundabout, take the 3rd exit & follow the signs for Green Isle Road/Boot Road. Continue along and the hotel is on your right.

From the M50, take exit 9 onto the N7 southbound, continue straight through the traffic lights at Newlands Cross and take the next exit left marked Kingswood. At the top of the slip road, take the 3rd exit off the roundabout. At the next roundabout, take the 3rd exit & follow the signs for Green Isle Road/Boot Road. Continue along and the hotel is on your right.



By Train: Trains run from Dublin and Belfast to Dundalk Clarke railway station (which is just 3km from the venue) and take approximately 1 hour.



By Air: The nearest airport is Dublin Airport: 22km (approx 20 mins).
