Playing Sections & Rate of Play

Masters, rating of 2000 and over, Majors 1600 – 1999, Challengers, 1200 – 1599
Juniors, 1199 or under, including unrated players.

Players whose ratings are within 100 points of the threshold for a higher section may, if they wish compete in the higher section.

Entrants without an Irish rating will be allocated to the playing section appropriate to their estimated playing strength at the discretion of the tournament controller.

The rates of play are 2 hours per player in the Masters and Majors Sections and 1 hour and 45 minutes per player in the Challengers and Juniors Sections. Masters Section will be FIDE rated.

Entry fees

Masters, Majors & Challengers €45 per player (€35 if payment is received on or before Thursday 14^{th} April 2011). Juniors €30 per player.

€30 for players aged 18 or under on 14th April (all Sections).

Cheques should be made payable to the "Leinster Chess Union". Players are required to bring their own board, set and clock please. Non ICU members will not be allowed to compete in the tournament FIDE Rules as per ICU handbook, and Leinster Chess Union rules will apply
