

GLORNEY CUP, 1965.  
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The 1965 Glorney Cup matches were held at the new University of Strathclyde, Glasgow, during the first week of August. Playing conditions have never been bettered in the event's 18 year-old history, and all teams expressed appreciation of the excellent arrangements made by the Scottish organizer, Gerald Bonner.

Indicative of the more serious approach to the game that is growing in the British Isles, was the training sessions that both Scottish and English teams engaged in prior to the event. Under the guidance of the President of the Scottish Chess Association, W. A. Fairhurst, the Scottish boys had received special coaching for several weeks, while members of the English team had taken part in a training tournament in London, and the whole team met in Liverpool for a pre-Glorney practice match against a strong Lancashire side gathered together by T. J. Beach. The benefits derived by the players from this help was soon evident, for at Glasgow the interest built up to the final round clash between the English boys and their Scottish hosts. Tension lasted till after the time set for the prize giving when in the last game to finish the English player, T. C. Fox, missed a winning line and the ensuing draw made Scotland outright winners for the first time.

Councillor William Taylor welcomed the participants at the opening ceremony at which Mr. Fairhurst presided. It must have afforded the Scottish president great satisfaction and made his efforts feel well worth while, when he saw Mrs. Bloodworth hand the Glorney Cup to the captain of the Scottish team at the Prize-Giving Ceremony.

Best result prizes went to J. L. Moles (Ireland), A. J. Hughes and A. H. Williams (Wales), T. C. Fox (England), F. McKenna (Scotland), and R. D. Keene (England), Lightning Tournament winner.

The complete absence of incidents bore witness to the admirable control exercised by P. B. Anderson, a veteran of Glorney Cup administration.

The meeting of the International Glorney Cup Committee was one of the most important ever held. The whole future of the event was discussed frankly and far reaching decisions made.

All four home countries accepted a new rota whereby the event can be staged on the continent every fourth year, and at similar intervals in England with foreign teams competing. This means that Ireland, Scotland and Wales will act as host country every 6th year. An invitation from the French Chess Federation to play in Paris in 1966 was accepted and the committee decided in favour of the method of games total to arrive at the winning team in future.

The best use to which the funds available should be put received considerable attention and general priorities were set out.

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Writing as a disgruntled Englishman, fully aware that this, "second Bannockburn," has created Glorney history (England failing to win the cup, or share it, for the first time in the annals of the competition!) the highlights of the disaster (from England's point of view) can be summed up as follows:-

WHITELEY, whose play in previous rounds had been somewhat laboured, and DENMAN, both lost material and were fortunate to draw, while THOMSON, despite his perpetual grin, was obviously suffering from a gross attack of hallucinations. LEE, the Midland U/18 Champion, whose imaginative play in the first two rounds had already created an excellent impression, strained to win in an attempt to redeem the situation on the other boards, overplayed his hand sealing a bad move, and lost rapidly on resumption. FOX, the London Junior Champion, failed to exploit an extra pawn. Only WISE won well for England. Since he is now only sixteen, has scored 2/2 in this event as well as winning the West of England Junior Championship with 6/6, we should soon be hearing more of him.

However, for the 1966 Glorney, which will be held in Paris and will include at least two continental teams England should be able to avail herself advantageously of the obvious talent of Fox, Lee, Wise, Denman and Holmes and also L. S. Tate, who is rapidly making a name for himself. And, again from the viewpoint of a defeated "Sassenach," we hope to be able to regain the cup which has now crossed the border.

In conclusion I feel that mention should be made of the "untiring" efforts of Messrs. Morrish and Sinclair, without whom many of the English team would not have arrived in Glasgow.
