situated in Dublin and if you are interested in pursuing this idea, then I will be very pleased to give you the rest of the plan and to do whatever I can (mainly in linking with the US Chess Federation and other US chess organisations that could help to promote the idea) to bring the plan to fruition.

On the CADCEC front I will endeavour to ensure that Ireland is included among those countries which receive help at the next congress in Thessaloniki.

It is also possible that the CADCEC seminars in Thessaloniki will be videoed. If this does not prove to be the case, then I will ensure that the ICU gets at least one set.

I hope you find this letter useful and I will, of course, be pleased to help further if I possibly can.
